

If you have upgraded your PC or Laptop to the latest Windows 10, you will notice the new Internet Browser has become MS Edge. You may also notice that Portable Document Format (PDF's) that were once fill-able and/or email-able no longer work.

Microsoft Edge incorporated their own version of the PDF program which trumps how our forms are created. Here is a fix:

1. Click on the hyperlink to open the form.
2. Click on the "three dots ..." at the upper right side of your window. (Figure 1 below)
3. Select "Open with Internet Explorer".
4. The document will open in Internet Explorer.
