Ninth Annual Kansas Workforce Summit
“Going for the Green”

WKMA is preparing for the 9th Annual Kansas Workforce Summit to be held January 20 & 21, 2010. This years program, *“Taking Education, Economic Development and Employment to the Next Level: **Going For the Green**.”* will once again be held at the Topeka Capitol Plaza.

Daniel Stenberg, Midwest Governors’ Association, Washington D.C., will headline discussing workforce creation and retraining in the new energy economy. The MGA is known for fostering regional development to attain greater efficiency in state administration, facilitating interstate cooperation and improving intergovernmental relationships, and providing a medium for the exchange of views and experiences on subjects of general importance to the people of the Midwestern states. He will be joined by Ron Painter from the National Association of Workforce Boards and Domenic Giandomenico from the Institute for a Competitive Workforce. A legislative update will once again be held as well as an update from the U.S. Department of Labor. *All employers are strongly encouraged to attend this forum to provide input for the legislature.*

Governor Mark Parkinson will open the Summit along with Acting Department of Commerce Secretary Bill Thornton.

Registration for the 2010 Summit is once again limited to 300 participants. Standard registrations at \$209 per person will be accepted through January 13, with late registrations at \$259 per person accepted thereafter.
