



The following guidelines have been put in place in accordance with Western State Bank Expo Center requirements and the recommendation of the CDC and WHO regarding social distancing and public health. Attendees should review the current CDC and WHO guidelines prior to the 2021 3i SHOW, *March 18-20*, and refrain from attending the show if they have been in contact with anyone exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms within the last 14 days, have a fever or other symptoms, or are immune compromised.

An inherent risk of exposure of COVID-19 exists in any setting where people are present.

The 2021 3i SHOW will be open to the public. 3i SHOW staff asks that they attend in accordance with the health protocols contained herein and any applicable local, state, or federal mandates.

Exhibitors, Attendees and Arenas:

- Exhibitors and attendees will be responsible for providing and utilizing their own personal protective equipment, including but not limited to face protection personal hand sanitizer, gloves, etc. Face protection and hand sanitizing stations will be placed around the show grounds.
- Face protection/face coverings are **NOT** required per WSBE and Ford County guidelines. While not required, it is still recommended to wear a face mask/cover, social distance, and wash hands frequently.
- Follow CDC guidance if symptoms develop. *Based on guidance from health authorities, anyone with a temperature of 100°F or above should not attend.*
- Exhibitors will be placed with an extra space per exhibit to follow social distancing guidelines.
- Exhibitors and attendees are encouraged not to congregate in groups of larger than 10 people and follow social-distancing guidelines.
- For events in the Presentation Area, chairs will be spread out in a larger area at the back of the WSBE concrete floor. The larger area will allow those from the same household to sit together and provide more space between the rows.
- Equipment used in the Presentation Area will be sanitized between presentations.

- For events in the Special Events Arena, those seated in the stands will be asked to leave two (2) vacant seats between each person from a separate household.
- Exhibitors must submit an online fillable COVID-19 Health Acknowledgement & Liability Waiver before Thursday, March 18. The completed waiver is necessary to participate in the event.

Show Office

- Exhibitors will still check-in with the Show Office during setup.
- Exhibitors that did **NOT** submit the online fillable waiver will be asked to complete the form before they can setup.
- 3i SHOW Office personnel will have face masks to hand out for any exhibitor interested.
- Show Office doors will be left open during setup and show hours to insure air flow during high traffic periods.
- Signage will be placed around seating areas and throughout the facility to encourage safe social distancing.
- While unable to enforce participation, 3i staff asks that exhibitors and attendees abide by the health protocols to ensure a safe and healthy environment.
