

Cobett waterers have unique features that set them apart from other waterers.

Cobett waterers' winter endurance and versatility provide many benefits. Daily minimum traffic, or heating devices, aren't needed to prevent freezing of the plumbing and valve. This is due to the system being buried underground. Each system utilizes ground heat which allows the water in the tub to be constantly warmed or cooled by the surrounding underground temperatures.

As a buried system, concrete is not required. However, it's recommended that gravel or concrete be placed around the unit to prevent muddy conditions around the waterer. Drinking height can be established at ten to twenty inches.

Two sizes of Cobett waterers are available with three standard sizes of base tube options, with more options of base tubes. Determination of base tube length is based on how deep the waterline needs to be buried to be safe from freezing. Cobett offers three different pressure valves and one gravity flow valve to suit different operations. Cobett representatives can help determine a system for you.

Cobett's open drinking area allows new/young livestock to easily begin drinking. Plumbing and valves are easily accessible. The tubs are easy to clean because they're removable! Cobett waterers' durability and long life are due to the black color, round design, UV inhibited polyethylene, heavy duty, solid wall thickness - 1" for the Large model, and 3/4" for the Small model, and the buried installation. The expected lifespan of a Cobett waterer could be 40 years or more.
